

# A CANCER DIAGNOSIS - not too late to stop smoking!

AstraZeneca welcomes you to this webinar with a focus on smoking cessation in lung cancer patients, and treating tobacco addiction.

Studies show that cancer patients who continue to smoke have increased mortality, decreased efficacy of radiation and medication therapies, increased treatment-related toxicity, a higher risk of recurrence, and a higher risk of an additional primary cancers. International guidelines therefore recommend that patients discontinue all use of tobacco products during cancer treatment.

Renè van Helvoirt is one of the leading radiation oncologists in Norway.

Renè van Helvoirt has been treating lung cancer patients for over 20 years. He has addressed important considerations for the optimal assistance of potentially curable patients undergoing chemoradiotherapy. For years, he has focused on the consequences of continued smoking in cancer patients. He has also initiated and recently concluded a registration and intervention study of smoking cancer patients in Norway.

In this lecture, van Helvoirt will discuss the negative effects of smoking in cancer patients, and how we can motivate patients to stop smoking.



### Serena Tonstad

One of Norway's leading preventive cardiologist. She holds a position at the Section of Preventive Cardiology at the Department of Endocrinology, Morbid Obesity and Preventive Medicine, Oslo University Hospital.

Tonstad has a high level of professional expertise in several areas, and has a special interest and expertise in the field of smoking cessation. She has written several articles on the subject, and has given many lectures on the importance of quitting smoking.
